## Sequence for an NPDES Permit in WWTP Design and Construction for Public Facilities



**Reginald Williamson** from **GA-EPD** presented on the NPDES permitting process and issues related to the publicly funded Wastewater Treatment Plant Design. NPDES permit is mandatory for all Wastewater Treatment Plants that require a discharge to waters of the State and constructed throughout the State of Georgia.
